ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Eligible candidates may apply in the prescribed forms provided by the college along with copies of the mark sheets, certificates of the qualifying examination and the requisite course fee.



Documents Required For Admission:

- Self-attested photocopies of HSLC Marksheet, Certificate and Admit Card (three Sets)
- Four copies of recent passport size photographs signed by the candidate on the back side.
- Students who passed matriculation/10th exam from other boards (other than SEBA) have to submit the original copy of Migration Certificate.



- Rank holders in HS from our college will be awarded with Rs. 1 lac.




FACULTY
